King of Glory – King of Peace

A Festival Service in King's College Chapel Saturday 21 September 2019

The Archdeaconry of Cambridge Church Music Society invites you and your singing friends to share in our biennial Festival of Church Music to be held in King's College Chapel on Saturday 21 September 2019.

As in recent years, we are not asking parish church choirs to robe and there will be no formal procession into the Chapel at King's.

We are delighted to announce that Mr David Poulter has agreed to direct the 2019 Festival. David, who has been director of music at the cathedrals of Chester, Coventry and Liverpool, is now living in Cambridgeshire and is keen to share his wealth of choral experience with us.

The music is to be taken from the **RSCM Festival Book entitled "King of Glory, King of Peace"**. If you took part in the RSCM Festival at Ely Cathedral in May 2018, you may already have a copy. If not, have a supply of copies for purchase (see overleaf for costs).

The music is as follows:

Psalms	145 (p. 32 to Anglican chant)
Anthems	O Sing to the Lord – Peter Nardone (p. 2) Nunc Dimittis – Grayston Ives (p. 173) And the Glory of the Lord – Handel's Messiah* Te Deum in F – John Ireland (p. 106)

There are two **compulsory** rehearsals on the day. **The church of St Giles, Castle Street (opposite Kettles Yard) CB3 0AQ has been booked for the first rehearsal.** There is no parking near the church, but it is only eight minutes by bus from Madingley Park & Ride. If you would have difficulty walking from St Giles to King's College (it takes about ten minutes on foot) let us know, as we are considering arranging transport for those who are less mobile. It is very important that you please email us at info@accms.org to let us know numbers for this transport well in advance.

The second rehearsal will be in King's College Chapel, after which you will be free for an hour.
